When it comes to iOS, Apple has a history of making a few mistakes before working out the major bugs in its software.Apple's last major iOS release, iOS 10, was the subject of much criticism after it left users' devices frozen, forcing some to perform a factory reset, losing data that wasn't backed up. The launch of iOS 8 and its novel HealthKit feature left certain developers' apps non-functional. The updated version, iOS 8.0.1, fixed the HealthKit error but prevented users from connecting to their cellular networks, in addition to reports of Touch ID errors (they fixed those bugs in iOS 8.0.2).
